President's Message

Thank you Cecile and Dolly for the magnificent job they did at USS Plaza. They put their order in for the weather to cooperate and boy did it. I have to say that this one of the best events at USS Plaza ever. Everything from the weather to the band (Jimmy Sapianza and Five Guys named Moe) made this an event you should have been at.

Interior (Last month the Exterior)

1 Remove the floor mats. Shake them out to remove dust, dirt, and debris. Place them on the ground for vacuuming at a later time. However, you can vacuum them right away if you want. It is your preference.

2 Remove large pieces of trash. Pick up large pieces of trash like paper, coins, pens, and other objects from your floorboard using your hands. Place these items in a trash bag. Wear latex gloves to protect your hands from getting dirty.

Use a BBQ skewer to remove dirt and pieces of trash from small crevices like in between seats.

Make sure to remove trash from cup holders as well.

3 Spray a glass cleaner into the cup holders. Let the glass cleaner set for 5 to 10 minutes. Then use a paper towel to clean out the dirt and grime. Use the BBQ skewer to pick out grime and dirt from any small crevices.

Alternatively, place an old sock on the bottom of a mug or travel cup. Then place the mug in the cup holder and twist to remove dirt and grime.

4 Vacuum from the top down. Start at the top of the seats, dashboard, and console before moving to the floor. Use the upholstery nozzle to vacuum the seats, upholstered areas, and the headliner. Use the brush attachment to vacuum the components that contain hard vinyl, plastic, and metal such as the dashboard and console. To clean small crevices and tight areas, use the crevice attachment.

Adjust the seats backwards and forwards to clean hard to reach spots under the seats.

5 Use a carpet cleaner to clean carpet stains. Spray the cleaner onto the stain and use a stiff bristle brush to rub it into the carpet. Be careful not to spray too much cleaner onto the carpet as this can cause mildew if it is not dried thoroughly. Use a clean, dry towel to blot the stains and dry the area.

6 Spray a foam cleanser onto fabric stains. Rub the cleanser into the stain with a soft brush. Let the cleanser dry. Then use a vacuum to remove it per the instructions. If the stain remains, then spray more cleanser onto the affected area and clean again until it is gone. If your seats are leather, then make sure to use a leather cleanser or saddle soap to clean your seats, as well as other components of the car that contain leather.

Interior (Last month the Exterior)

7 Use car wipes to sanitize the dashboard and console. Make sure to use specially formulated car wipes. You can find these at your local auto shop. Use Q-tips or cotton swabs to clean small areas like radio buttons, air vents, and panel seams. If you do not have car wipes, then an all-purpose household cleaner that is ammonia-free will do.

8 Clean the windows with a glass cleaner. Any household glass cleaner will do. Instead of spraying the cleaner directly onto the window, spray it onto a clean, microfiber towel. Then wipe both the inside and outside of your windows in a straight up and down motion. Roll down your windows to thoroughly clean the top section of the window.

9 Re-vacuum the car. This will remove any dirt and grime that was knocked out during the cleaning process. Then shake and vacuum the floor mats thoroughly if you have not already done so. Place them inside your car.

Use an odor-removal spray, like Febreze, to remove any remaining smells from your car.

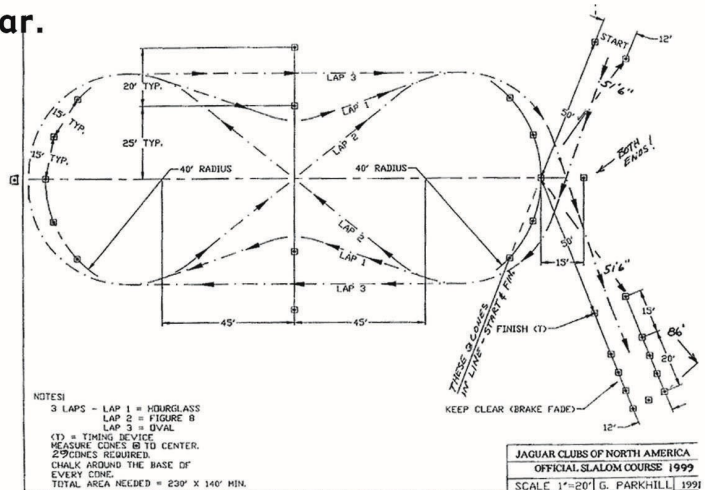



This is a very quiet but elegant venue for our annual Sewickley Show, formally know as “The Annual Display of Exceptional Automobiles”. The date is **August 10, 2019** and once again, we’re on Together with guests from the Rolls Royce Owners Club, Classic Car Club of America. We will again have an exciting grouping, that will represent a breathtaking array of interesting cars ... Jaguars! ... Rolls Royces! ... Bentleys! ... and great Classics! Cars are parked with generous space in between, sufficient for everyone to get a close look of each, while “shoot-the-breeze” talking about all the thing that car junkies among us love to share! Plus there are plenty of appreciative passersby and trophies to be awarded. Also, we are very appreciative for the regular annual support from Bobby Rahal Jaguar, who has renewed their sponsorship for yet another year. They will also be displaying a two new Jaguars and will be providing an impressive array of door prizes, just as they have typically done for each of many years now.

Register now - it surely will be another great event not be missed. As in past years, participants can choose to be in either of two categories, “Display Only” (not judged), or the “Judged” category. Though judging is not mandatory, it is conducted in a very casual fashion that is best described as “Concours-lite”. It does NOT involve the demanding detail of a formal Concours, but has just enough to still be relaxed and simple. Due to the limited size of the venue, we are limited to 50 cars.

WHEN: Saturday, August 10th, 2019 rain or shine.

TIME: Check in 10:00 AM - 11:00 AM at the registration table.

Final cleaning 10:00 AM – 12:30 PM. Judging begins at 12:30 PM. Awards 3:00 PM

SHOWING OPTIONS:

Category #1 -- Non-Judged. (Display only)

Category #2 -- Judging & eligible for a trophy according to categories based on registration. Classes will be mixed marques, generally grouped according “decades” (i.e, cars of the 20’s, 30’s, 40’s, 50’s, 60’s, 70’s, etc), with adjustments as necessary for unique cases. The usual informal judging format (not a formal Concours) will be used, and a maximum of three trophies will be awarded in each class.

Emphasis is on appearance, cleanliness, and fundamental originality (specifically, originality will be basic and informal, and NOT with excruciating detail).

PEOPLE’S CHOICE AWARDS: Three trophies (Jaguar, Rolls/ Bentley, and Other Classic) with the most votes will be awarded according to votes cast by the admiring public. Any registered entry is eligible to win, provided it has not won a 1st place People’s Choice award in the last 2 years of this show. Both judged and display-only entries are eligible.

REGISTRATION: Registration fees are as noted below. All registrations must be received by August 9, 2019. Provided space is available, registration will be \$10 more on the day of the show. Please REGISTER EARLY, it helps us determine classes in advance. Judged Category is ONLY available to advanced registration. Day of show entries can only be in the non-judged “display only” category. Registration is complete once your check & application are received in the mail, or via email scan of this form. Your registration materials etc. will be distributed the morning of the show, upon your arrival.
