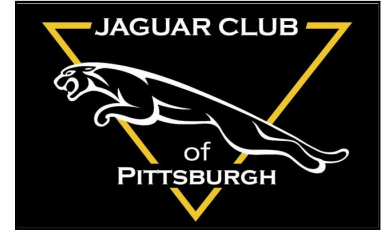

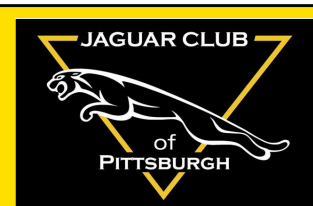

As members of JCOP are now well aware, the Coventry Foundation was formed some years ago to be the primary source for information and materials related to the heritage of Jaguar Cars in North America. It has been approved by the Internal Revenue Service as an approved Charitable Organization pursuant to Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code. Gary Kincl of JCOP is the Chairman of the Board of the Coventry Foundation.

This month we will report on “The Story of the [Large] Leaper” that is now at the Coventry Foundation headquarters in Columbia, SC after spending the previous five years at Gary Kincl’s garage in White Oak, PA. Photographs will hopefully assist in understanding the size of this “piece” of Jaguar history. Additionally, one of our JCOP members – Jim Dolan – is participating in the LeMans Classic Race June 30, 2022 through July 3, 2022 in LeMans, France.

THE STORY OF THE LEAPER

As ferreted out of Gary Kincl, the story began back in 2017 when Fred Hammond (who works for Jaguar Land Rover North America and is not only their historian but an active participant with the Jaguar Clubs of North America and just a super fellow all around) contacted Gary Kincl. Fred shared that JLR had a large “Display Leaper” that JLR had in a storage unit in Brooklyn, NY. JLR was incurring charges for the storage garage and decided they wanted to get out of the storage unit along with the expense. JLR offered the Leaper, which came with a large Jaguar



sign, to the Coventry Foundation if the Coventry Foundation would come and pick it up. As anyone who knows Gary would predict, he immediately told Fred ‘Yes, we want it’ and then figured out how to get it. Not surprisingly, Gary ended up having to do it by taking his truck, with a large trailer he owns, to Brooklyn, NY to get the Leaper. There was a surprise involved, however, since Gary happened to be in communication with Jack Terrick of JCOP and to Gary’s good fortune, Jack and his family were visiting Jack’s daughter in New York City and Jack offered to come over to Brooklyn, meet Gary upon arrival, and help load The Leaper onto Gary’s trailer. Indeed, Jack’s son Andy also came along and was a huge help in these guys having to manhandle these huge “pieces” from the storage unit into the trailer and then securing them properly so Gary could return safely to Pittsburgh. Some photographs were – fortunately – taken of Jack, Gary, and Andy that your author was able to obtain to accompany this story. (Andy is in the yellow shirt and Jack, of course, is wearing the green sweatshirt; Gary is wearing black apparel.)

After tying up Gary's trailer for some time in White Oak, PA, Gary bit the bullet and got The Leaper and Jaguar sign out of the trailer that he needed to use for other purposes and he stored them in his garage space while awaiting news about the ever present hope that the Coventry Foundation was going to acquire more space in Columbia, SC where these pieces could be displayed. It took some time but after almost five years "The Leaper" and the large Jaguar sign made the "leap" to Columbia, SC the weekend of May 28, 2022. Gary Kincel was going to Columbia, SC that weekend for the very special celebratory events including the donation by Roger Wright of his 1961 Mark II Saloon (which was one of the subjects in the June Coventry Corner). The Coventry Foundation had obtained more space in Columbia, SC and Gary decided "it was time" to get



"The Leaper" to its new home. Gary again called Jack Terrick and asked for his assistance and counsel. Jack

brought with him Rob Stutzman, one of the newest members of JCOP (Rob owns an E-Type Coupe). Gary, Jack, and Rob then manhandled "The Leaper" and the Jaguar sign back into Gary's trailer and the loading went well. Gary reports his trip went uneventfully (although one can only imagine how much it cost in gasoline to haul this load to Columbia, SC) but Gary's Honda truck with now over 204,000 miles made the round trip with the trailer just fine. Gary said the drive back north with an empty trailer was much easier.

Upon arrival at the Coventry Foundation, a crew of volunteers there for the celebratory weekend unloaded "The Leaper" along with the accompanying Jaguar sign and the rest of the

structure where all these pieces fit together. After uncrating, It was measured to be 11' long and will be about 11' tall once all the pieces are assembled together, according to your Reporter's understanding from Gary.

CHEER ON TEAM DOLAN AT THE LeMANS CLASSIC JUNE 30 – JULY 3, 2022

JCOP member – and longtime, accomplished vintage racer - Jim Dolan is looking forward to the time of his life when he has been entered into the 10th LeMans Classic races in LeMans, France between June 30 and July 3, 2022. While we look forward to providing more information next

month, Jim is driving his 1966 Ford GT40 with sons Brian, Charlie, and Peter, making for a Dolan/Dolan/Dolan/Dolan team. On Monday, June 20th the car left via air freight – Fed Ex delivers anything. There are 70 cars in the Dolan team Group 5, of which eleven are GT40's. Only four entrants are from the USA in the 70 cars in Group 5 and significant entry names in group 6 include Jim Farley (the CEO of Ford Motor Company) and the Prince of Denmark.

There will be 1000 racing drivers in 700 racing cars. Included in these will be 11 GT40s with a top speed of about 200 mph on the Mulsanne Straight (not a breakfast cereal or alcoholic drink). The projection is that there will be 200,000 spectators along with an additional 8,500 cool club cars and 200 exhibitors. There certainly will be numerous alcoholic drinks enjoyed by many of these folks, if not also breakfast cereal. The entire Dolan clan is accompanying the Dolan Racing Team; they have reserved a large French chateau (mansion) to house them for this experience of a lifetime. They had planned to be there last year but everything in France got canceled due to COVID-19.

So 2022 is here and the Dolans are there, in France. Check out the YouTube videos both pre-Lemans Classic racing coming up, during the 10th Lemans Classic, and afterwards. Keep your eyes peeled to look for the blue GT40 car # 28. All three of the Dolan sons are just simply amazing race car drivers not to mention impressive young men in every regard. Just like Dad.
