President's Message

Following is the latest on my 95 V12, and a word to the wise for those with aging modern Jags.

I was able to change the faulty rear speed sensor on the automatic gearbox last week, with the driving experience returning to normal. This \$12 tachometer sensor on the exterior of the gearbox is held in place by a single bolt, but limited access meant dropping a large section of the exhaust. About 8 hours later (not all in one session) it was back in place with eight bolted flanges welded in place. Next up on the surprise list, one oil cooler (engine, not gearbox cooler!!) flex line suddenly split, with the result of dumping dearly all the engine oil on the road. Fortunately it happened less than half a mile from home while inbound, and it does not appear there was any engine damage. These lines are going to be difficult to remove and repair due to poor access. New flex lines will have to be made up at the hydraulic shop. So, if you have an early XK8 or XJS, which may also have similar (poor factory quality) cooler lines, I recommend you add these to

your preventive maintenance schedule before you get a nasty surprise.

Last Sunday's drive to Jennerstown was wonderful and very well attended. Dave and Karen Murray led the way on a series of scenic and twisty roads meandering through the countryside. After a great meal at the very scenic Green Gables Restaurant, the group moved over to the Mountain Playhouse to see a performance of The Bikinis. Thanks to Dave and Karen, and Jack Terrick and Jack Mancuso who helped lead two of the three groups of cars from our meeting point in New Stanton to our destination in Jennerstown.

I hope those who attended this year's U.S. Steel Tower Plaza Annual Display of Jaguars on June 7 enjoyed the day. Thanks to Cecile Canales and Dolly Taskey for their planning and for making this event a success.

Finally, your Board of Directors met on June 17, and I can say that we are planning a very special November event for the club. A committee has been formed to finalize details and more information will be forthcoming soon.

I hope to see you at one or more of the upcoming Marque of the Year events coming up over the next two weeks. There will be a car event to suit every taste, so please try to get out and join the fun with your Jag.

Register now - it surely will be another great event not be missed. As in past years, participants can choose to be in either of two categories, "Display Only' (not judged), or the "Judged" category. Though judging is not mandatory, it is conducted in a very casual fashion that is best described as "Concours-lite". It does NOT involve the demanding detail of a formal Concours, but has just enough to still be relaxed and simple. Due to the limited size of the venue, we are limited to 50 cars.

WHEN: Saturday, August 6th, 2016 rain or shine.
TIME: Check in 10:00 AM - 11:00 AM at the registration table.
Final cleaning 10:00 AM - 12:30 PM. Judging begins at 12:30 PM. Awards 3:00 PM

SHOWING OPTIONS:

Category #1 -- Non-Judged. (Display only)

Category #2 -- Judging & eligible for a trophy according to categories based on registration. Classes will be mixed marques, generally grouped according "decades" (i.e, cars of the 50's, 60's, 70's, 80's, 90's etc), with adjustments as necessary for unique cases. The usual informal judging format (not a formal Concours) will be used, and a maximum of three trophies will be awarded in each class. Emphasis is on appearance, cleanliness, and fundamental originality (Note: originality will be basic and informal, and will NOT be viewed with excruciating detail).

PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARDS: Three trophies (Jaguar, Rolls/ Bentley, and Italian Cortile) with the most votes will be awarded according to votes cast by the admiring public. Any registered entry is eligible to win, provided it has not won a 1st place People's Choice award in the last 2 years of this show. Both judged and display-only entries are eligible.

REGISTRATION: Registration fees are as noted below. All registrations must be received by August 5, 2016. Provided space is available registration will be \$10 more on the day of the show. Please register early, it helps determine classes in advance. Judged Category is ONLY available to advanced registration. Day of show entries can only be in the non-judged "display only" category. Registration is complete once your check & application are received in the mail, or via email scan of this form. Your registration packet and show materials will be distributed the morning of the show, upon your arrival.
